LAI Academic Year 2024-2025: A Prodigy of Innovation


Dear LAI Community of Students, Teachers & Parents,

Just as explorers chart unknown territories, our educational mission drives us to continuously adapt and evolve to meet the complex demands of a rapidly changing world. Continuing with its legacy of excellence, Learning Alliance International harnessed its potential as a future-facing institution this year as well. As the Academic Year 2025 concludes, and I address you in my capacity as the Head of Academics at LAI, my narrative will encompass the remarkable accomplishments of this past year, featuring some of the laurels we have brought home while foreshadowing the future horizons for the upcoming academic year, thus evidencing LAI as a true prodigy of innovation.

As a team of trailblazing educators, we continued to ponder the big question: "What must be the end goal of education, and how can we create meaningful learning experiences?" While there is no static answer to this, it cannot be denied that the recurring global challenges have rendered evolution in academia of paramount importance. From the ancient Socratic Method to the Artificial Intelligence-infused 21st-century classrooms, from Plato's Academy to Hypatia's contribution to knowledge, from Ibn Khaldun's Muqaddimah to LAI's quest for creative classrooms, educational innovation has continued to remain a significant constant in shaping societies. At LAI, we continued to center learning experiences as the true vehicle of change, prompting all members of our team to approach teaching with the curiosity and imagination of a learner.

As a team of IB Risk-Takers, Thinkers, and Communicators, we role-modeled attributes of the IB Learner Profile: from international competitions to national wins, from acing external DP and MYP exams to excelling during the PYP exhibitions, from community partnerships to international placements, from pursuing learner well-being to ensuring equal opportunities through both curricular and extracurricular activities. The learning experiences we have created, both within and beyond the walls of the classroom, reflect the IB philosophy of 'thinking critically.'

This zeal for promoting innovation was witnessed as we hosted the 2nd IB Ripple Global Conference, empowering 476+ student presenters from 11 countries to exhibit their research acumen. It was, by far, the biggest global student research conference in the IB World. Furthermore, we became the first school in



Pakistan to partner with Citizens UK to launch a digital portfolio for all our IB learners, helping them document their extracurricular activities, which is, in essence, a LinkedIn for children.

Similar feats of excellence were exhibited throughout the year as we designed capacity-building INSETs featuring avenues for teacher development through rigorous workshops, nano professional developments, and model lessons. We also hosted a global version of Scope & Sequence Symposia for reviewing and upskilling our IB curricula on a meta scale, in collaboration with partner schools from around the world. We launched pilots for initiatives such as LAI Reads (to enhance the reading capabilities of learners) and LAI WITS (Webinars on Innovation in Teaching Spheres), with learners as the beneficiaries. We also ran a whole-school intervention called 'Leading & Learning with Artificial Intelligence,' which featured both policy and practice reform across the IB Continuum. As part of this, we launched a tailor-made teaching module named 'Artificial Intelligence' for our DP students, 'Is AI Too Cool for Middle School?' for MYP students, and 'PYP's Seat on the AI Policy Table' for PYP. We also held professional development workshops for our teaching teams.

However, all innovation must also be re-innovated to match the growing and changing needs of the community, and that vision remains our North Star. We are indebted to Ms. Anjum Ahmed (CEO/Executive Principal) for being the force behind LAI's vision, to Mr. Nael Ahmed (Director of Operations) for his consistent guidance as a thought leader, and to Ms. Farah Masood (Principal) for her unwavering faith and support for all these endeavors. We believe that it's our individual consciousness and collective efforts that contribute to both national and global accolades.

Hence, this prodigy of innovation continues with heightened determination and commitment to our cause: the learners of LAI — the changemakers of tomorrow!

Our students also excelled in Sports, winning numerous medals - MYP IV students secured a silver medal in the U15 Football Boys category at the Gulf Winter Cup in Dubai. In Chess, an MYP II student earned the Woman Candidate Master (WCM) title at the Chess Olympiad in Budapest, while others achieved significant national and international victories. Additionally, the MYP V and DP play, 'Lend Me a Tenor' captivated the audience with stellar performances.

IB Tesseract 2025 showcased student inquiry and excellence through projects like the MYP Personal Project, DP Extended Essay, DP TOK, and DP CAS. The MYP V Personal Project exhibition was especially noteworthy, with students presenting their work and engaging in meaningful discussions about their creative processes and outcomes.

We are proud to announce that one of our students was selected for the Youth Ambassador Programme, a joint initiative by HundrED and the International Baccalaureate. Chosen from over 1,100 participants, this honor underscores her commitment to addressing the Sustainable Development Goals.

To our graduating MYP V batch awaiting their eAssessment results, we are confident you're ready for your next journey, equipped with skills, knowledge, and attributes for a successful Diploma Programme (DP). To our MYP I-IV students, we encourage you to embrace the new academic year with resilience and confidence.

The Academic Year 2024–25 has been nothing short of exceptional for LAI, with remarkable achievements in academics and extracurricular activities. A total of 109 students graduated from PYP V, MYP V, and DP II, stepping confidently into the world as future leaders ready to make meaningful contributions both globally and locally.


Our students demonstrated extraordinary academic success, with the highest IBDP score reaching 40/45 and a national benchmark class average of 37/45. Additionally, an MYP student achieved an impressive 55/56, the highest score in Pakistan. These milestones reflect the dedication of our students, the unwavering support of our faculty, and the strong academic foundation cultivated within LAI.

The graduating class of 2025 secured acceptances into some of the world's most prestigious universities, including NYU, University of Toronto, McGill University, UC San Diego, King's College London, University of Warwick, University of Edinburgh, George Washington University, Pennsylvania State University, UMass Amherst, Utrecht University, Hong Kong University, and Bocconi University. Collectively, students were awarded an impressive \$7.1 million in scholarships, with two students receiving full-ride scholarships to their top-choice universities.

Our students achieved remarkable milestones on global platforms. Two DP students were honoured as Global Youth Ambassadors, showcasing their leadership and making an international impact. A DP student was accepted into the Oxford University Summer School, reflecting the intellectual calibre and global opportunities available to LAI students.

In co-curricular activities, our students secured gold medals and top positions in renowned competitions such as Caribou Mathematics, Owlypia, and TeenEagle, while excelling in WEVOI and the Bulgarian Creative Writing Competition. LAI debaters made a significant impact at Harvard Model United Nations (HMUN), winning the prestigious 'Best Large Delegation' award alongside five individual honours. Sports remained a key pillar of achievement, with students excelling in multiple inter-school and intra-school competitions.

Beyond competitions, our students continued their commitment to creating a positive impact in their community. The CAS and Environmental Society conducted the LAI Ramzan Drive, a philanthropic initiative supporting underprivileged communities during the holy month of Ramzan.



The year was further enriched by dynamic events, including IB Flair, a platform for entrepreneurship; IB Ripple, a research-driven initiative; the Annual IB Play Lend Me a Tenor, celebrating artistic excellence; and IB Tesseract 2025, showcasing achievements in the MYP Personal Project, DP Extended Essay, TOK, and CAS.

As we celebrate this extraordinary year, we express our heartfelt gratitude to our students, faculty, and parents for their unwavering support. LAI remains dedicated to nurturing talent, fostering leadership, and preparing students for limitless opportunities ahead.
